NOTES:

1. Automatic failure on fourth absence per term (unless waived or buyback).
2. LET IIA students must have a final average of "C-" or higher to continue in LET IIB. Likewise, LET IIB students must also have a final average of "C-" or higher to continue in LET IIIA.
3. Seniors who choose to do so may participate in the LET IV service learning project. They must declare that option not later than the end of the fourth week of first term. Seniors who choose this option will be excused from the final exam, and will be graded under the senior option criterion. Bi-weekly (45-minute) after-school service learning class participation is required. Missing of more than one of these classes per term, or the missing the final project will result in automatic transfer back to the regular option for the remainder of the year.
4. The LET II curriculum includes many self-study assignments. Cadets are responsible for completing reading and written self-study assignments on their own. As many of these assignments are not discussed in detail during class, additional research is encouraged to ensure understanding. This material is testable.
5. The highest term and final grades for cadets who do not choose a leadership or staff position is an A- (90 pct).
