- ◆ If a module is missed, the exact same module must be made-up at a future class.
- ◆ MANDATORY virtual Parent Class. Parent Class must be taken prior to driving or observing on the road.
- Personal checks are not accepted. Minimum 1/2 payment due upon registration.
- Payment Plan options are available in two installments of \$125 each and must be paid in full on or before Mod 7.
