Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for Summer School a student must pass 50% of the course during the regular school year. In the case of a full year course, TWO TERMS must be passed. In the case of a semester course, ONE TERM must be passed.

Promotion Requirements

To be promoted at the end of summer school. the following credits must be successfully completed:

- Freshman to Sophomore = 27 credits
- Sophomore to Junior = 43 credits
- Junior to Senior = 66 credits
- Graduation = 95 credits

Important Notes

- Summer School is NOT mandatory. If your child does not participate in summer school, they **can repeat failed classes** in the fall. However, this will impact their class schedule and/or expected graduation date.
- Students can only take two (2) classes • during summer school *if they have met the* eligibility requirements.
