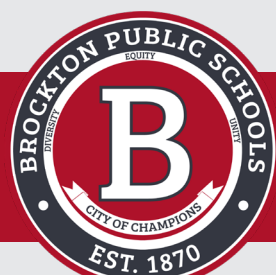


PROTOCOLS FOR COVID-19 EXPOSURE

We want to stress that when in doubt, keep your child home and call his/her school to consult a school nurse on self-isolation procedures.

Your child tests positive for COVID-19 and IS exhibiting symptoms.	Your child tests positive for COVID-19 but does NOT have any symptoms.	Your child has been identified as a close contact of an individual whom they interacted with OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL. *Students may **only** return to school at this time IF they have gone 24 hours without a fever (and without taking fever-reducing medications) and experienced improvement in other symptoms. Parents/guardians should closely monitor their child's symptoms for 14 days.
