The Little Red Schoolhouse Association, Inc. was formed in 1968. It is headed by a group of dedicated volunteers who continue to strive to preserve and maintain this historic "Little Red Schoolhouse" as a museum of educational history. The school, the last of the two room schoolhouses, affectionately remembered as the Forest Avenue School, opened in 1875 and closed its doors in June of 1963. It was saved from demolition and was moved onto the grounds of Brockton High School in 1969. Restoration was completed in 1976. The school stands as a monument to the solid foundation received in early elementary education. It serves as a tribute to the beloved teachers who strove to instill the basic three "R's". This school stands forever in cherished memories of pride in accomplishments by teachers, pupils and parents to preserve a piece of American heritage in Brockton. There are several general meetings each year and, with funding, several educational and entertainment programs.
